Heart of Gold Selection Criteria

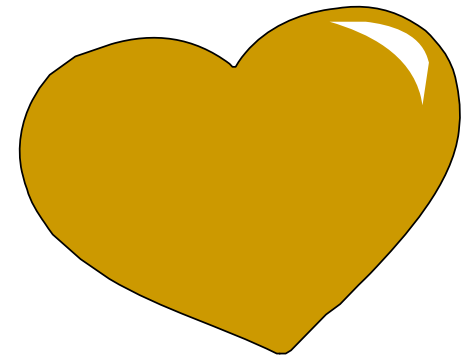
The Selection Committee will take into account the following factors in the selection process:
