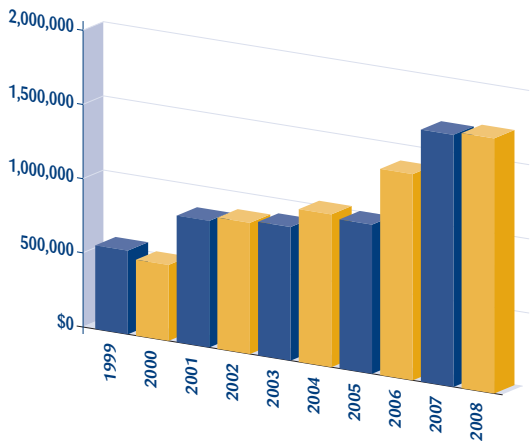
Assets Growth
