



AMERICAN TEEN SCHOLARSHIP

The American Teen Scholarship was created with gifts from Paramount Vantage and Warsaw Community High School in celebration of the movie **American Teen**, which debuted in theaters in 2008 and featured the lives of Warsaw Community High School students during their senior year.

For all Kosciusko County Community Foundation Scholarships ONLY –

- Submit an application for each scholarship applied for with all the required attachments. Staple all attachments to each application, no paper clips. Do not attach information sheets to applications. Submit all applications at the same time, do not mail individually, bundle all applications in the order listed in the index.

In **ONE ENVELOPE SUBMIT** THE FOLLOWING **TWO** ITEMS, regardless of the number of submitted applications. Do not attach the envelope to any one application. Please write the student's name on the envelope. Failure to submit both items in an envelope with the student's name will result in an incomplete application:

- **ONE PHOTO** – A newsprint quality photo (no larger than 3x5), with the student's name on the back of the photo.
- **ONE FAFSA'S STUDENT AID REPORT (SAR)** (the report FAFSA returns to you) including your name and the EFC (Expected Family Contribution) number. If ineligible to apply for FAFSA, obtain a Financial Aid Questionnaire from the Community Foundation.

Note: The IRS Form 1040 will not be accepted in place of the SAR.

Deadline for Submitting **April 1**

Required Attachments to the Standard Application Form Submit a copy of high school transcript including SAT/ACT scores or a copy of college transcript.

Two letters of recommendation, one being from a performing arts teacher.

Qualifications

- Must have graduated from Warsaw Community High School
- Must have participated in performing arts such as band, choir, theater or radio/TV while attending Warsaw Community High School.
- Must be pursuing a degree of a performing arts nature which could include but is not limited to vocal, instrumental, or musical performance, radio or television broadcasting, theatre, musical theatre, theatre and drama, acting, directing, screen writing, technology, film editing, costume or lighting.
- Must demonstrate financial need
