



# THE B. RINGLE AND ELEANORE RINGLE EDUCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP

As long term residents of the Warsaw-Winona Lake area, Mr. and Mrs. Ringle were actively interested in the community's affairs. Realizing the benefits of higher education, the Ringles created this fund by contributing assets having a value well in excess of \$100,000.00 from which the earnings were awarded annually in non-repayable scholarships to assist worthy students. Mr. and Mrs. Ringle, members of the First United Methodist Church of Warsaw, being cognizant of the value of religious training in church and in the home, stipulated church membership as a condition of eligibility.

For all Kosciusko County Community Foundation Scholarships ONLY –

- Submit an application for each scholarship applied for with all the required attachments. Staple all attachments to each application, no paper clips. Do not attach information sheets to applications. Submit all applications at the same time, do not mail individually, bundle all applications in the order listed in the index.

In **ONE ENVELOPE SUBMIT** THE FOLLOWING **TWO** ITEMS, regardless of the number of submitted applications. Do not attach the envelope to any one application. Please write the student's name on the envelope. Failure to submit both items in an envelope with the student's name will result in an incomplete application:

- **ONE PHOTO** – A newsprint quality photo (no larger than 3x5), with the student's name on the back of the photo.
- **ONE FAFSA'S STUDENT AID REPORT (SAR)**, ( the report FAFSA returns to you), including your name and the EFC (Expected Family Contribution) number. If ineligible to apply for FAFSA, obtain a Financial Aid Questionnaire from the Community Foundation.

**Note: The IRS Form 1040 will not be accepted in place of the SAR.**

## Required Attachments to the Standard Application Form

Submit a copy of high school transcript including SAT/ACT scores or a copy of college transcript.  
Submit a copy of birth certificate or documentation of US Citizenship.  
  
Two current letters of recommendation; one letter must be from the applicant's high school Principal, guidance counselor or a teacher of his or her high school, or if in college from a professor, and one letter must be from the pastor of his/her church.

## Qualifications

- Must be an American Citizen.
- Must have been a resident of Kosciusko County, Indiana, at the time of his or her graduation from high school.
- Must show evidence of financial need and a scholastic record indicative of a successful college career.
- Must be an active member of any religious faith who has been accepted at an accredited college or university.

## Eligibility

- High School Senior
- College Student
- Past Recipient

All applications and attachments **must** be delivered on or before **April 1**. Awards will be paid to the educational institution after acceptance and must be used for tuition, books, or fees.
