BRADY HOUCK MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

This award is given in memory of Brady Houck, who would have successfully graduated from Warsaw Community High School in 2007. Brady enjoyed playing high school football, racing go-karts and his work at Boggs Automotive. Following his death in a traffic accident, Brady's family and friends established this memorial scholarship to provide scholarship assistance to Warsaw Community High School graduating seniors or past graduates pursuing a career in technical, trade or machine work.

For all Kosciusko County Community Foundation Scholarships ONLY –

- Submit an application for each scholarship applied for with all the required attachments. Staple all attachments to each application, no paper clips. Do not attach information sheets to applications. Submit all applications at the same time, do not mail individually, bundle all applications in the order listed in the index.

In **ONE ENVELOPE SUBMIT THE FOLLOWING TWO** ITEMS, regardless of the number of submitted applications. Do not attach the envelope to any one application. Please write the student's name on the envelope. Failure to submit both items in an envelope with the student's name will result in an incomplete application:

- **ONE PHOTO** – A newsprint quality photo (no larger than 3x5), with the student's name on the back of the photo.
- **ONE FAFSA'S STUDENT AID REPORT (SAR)**, (the report FAFSA returns to you), including your name and the EFC (Expected Family Contribution) number. If ineligible to apply for FAFSA, obtain a Financial Aid Questionnaire from the Community Foundation.

Note: The IRS Form 1040 will not be accepted in place of the SAR.

Required Attachments to the Standard Application Form	Submit a copy of high school transcript, which may OR MAY NOT include SAT or ACT scores or a college transcript.
	Copy of birth certificate or documentation of US Citizenship
	Two <u>current</u> letters of recommendation with one being from an employer or coach.
Qualifications	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Must be a US Citizen and a resident of Kosciusko County, Indiana. ▪ Must be a graduate of Warsaw Community High School, graduating senior or past graduate. (GED does not qualify) ▪ Must demonstrate financial need. ▪ Must be enrolled in or plan to pursue trade school or technical training.
Eligibility	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Students must have had experience participating in athletic team activity and work experience as evidenced by employment at summer or part time job. ▪ Past award recipients are encouraged to reapply.

All applications and attachments **must** be delivered on or before **April 1**. Awards will be paid to the educational institution after acceptance and must be used for tuition, books, or fees.
