## CAMELOT SCHOLARSHIP FUND

This scholarship fund was created by the Shoop Sports and Youth Foundation, Inc. in memory of their founder J.Homer Shoop, to provide scholarship assistance to needy and deserving students who have graduated from Wawasee High School, Whitko High School and Warsaw Community High School.

For all Kosciusko County Community Foundation Scholarships ONLY –

- Submit an application for each scholarship applied for with all the required attachments. Staple all attachments to each application, no paper clips. Do not attach information sheets to applications. Submit all applications at the same time, do not mail individually, bundle all applications in the order listed in the index.

In **ONE ENVELOPE SUBMIT** THE FOLLOWING **TWO** ITEMS, regardless of the number of submitted applications. Do not attach the envelope to any one application. Please write the student’s name on the envelope. Failure to submit both items in an envelope with the student’s name will result in an incomplete application:

- **ONE PHOTO** – A newsprint quality photo (no larger than 3x5), with the student’s name on the back of the photo.
- **ONE FAFSA’S STUDENT AID REPORT (SAR)**, (the report FAFSA returns to you), including your name and the EFC (Expected Family Contribution) number. If ineligible to apply for FAFSA, obtain a Financial Aid Questionnaire from the Community Foundation.

**Note: The IRS Form 1040 will not be accepted in place of the SAR.**

**Required Attachments to the Standard Application Form** Submit a copy of high school transcript including SAT/ACT scores. Submit two current letters of recommendation; one letter from current or past employer and one from a non-related adult who knows of your activities through church, service organization or youth group.

- Qualifications
- Must have participated in community service through church, service organization or youth group.
  - Show evidence of financial need.
  - Must graduate in upper 50% of class.
  - Must demonstrate work ethic.

- Eligibility
- High School Senior from Warsaw, Wawasee or Whitko – not renewable

All applications and attachments **must** be delivered on or before **April 1**. Awards will be paid to the educational institution after acceptance and must be used for tuition, books, or fees.
