## DAVID L. CAREY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Dave Carey was a well-respected business owner and friend of the community. He operated Carey Excavating in North Webster for 40 years and Carey Realty in Warsaw for 20 years. He was a member of the North Webster Church of God, a board member of Mutual Bank in Warsaw, a 14-year member of the Wawasee School Board, and an 8-year member of Combined Community Services. Dave's father taught him the masonry trade and he felt learning a trade was important for young people. Throughout his involvement with Wawasee Schools, he especially appreciated the school's vocational and technical training opportunities.

- **ONE PHOTO** – A newsprint quality photo (no larger than 3x5), with the student's name on the back of the photo.

**NOTE:** This scholarship does not require submission of the FAFSA's SAR.

<b>Required Attachments to the Standard Application Form</b>	Submit a copy of high school transcript  Two current letters of reference: 1 from a coach or employer and 1 from a teacher in the field of study the applicant plans to pursue (cannot be the Director of the Career & Technical Services Department)
Qualifications	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Must be a graduating senior of Wawasee High School</li> <li>▪ Must plan to attend an accredited vocational or technical school or be entering a vocational or technical certification program.</li> <li>▪ Preference given to students involved in sports or extracurricular activities or who have documented employment history while in school.</li> </ul>
Eligibility	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Wawasee High School senior</li> <li>▪ Not renewable</li> </ul>

All applications and attachments **must** be delivered on or before **April 1**. Awards will be paid to the educational institution after acceptance and must be used for tuition, books, or academic fees.
