- Submit an application for each scholarship applied for with all the required attachments. Staple all attachments to each application, no paper clips. Do not attach information sheets to applications. Submit all applications at the same time, do not mail individually, bundle all applications alphabetically.

In **ONE ENVELOPE SUBMIT** THE FOLLOWING **TWO** ITEMS, regardless of the number of submitted applications. Do not attach the envelope to any one application. Please write the student's name on the envelope. Failure to submit both items in an envelope with the student's name will result in an incomplete application:

- **ONE PHOTO** – A newsprint quality photo (no larger than 3x5), with the student's name on the back of the photo.
- **ONE FAFSA'S STUDENT AID REPORT (SAR)**, (the report FAFSA returns to you), including your name and the EFC (Expected Family Contribution) number. If ineligible to apply for FAFSA, obtain a Financial Aid Questionnaire from the Community Foundation.

**Note: The IRS Form 1040 will not be accepted in place of the SAR.**

**Required Attachments to the Standard Application Form** Submit a copy of high school transcript including SAT/ACT scores or a copy of college transcript.

Submit two current letters of recommendation.

Qualifications	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Must be a resident of Kosciusko County, Indiana and show financial need.</li> </ul>
1 <sup>st</sup> Preference	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Applicant pursuing education and/or training to become a diesel mechanic, auto mechanic, motorcycle mechanic, small engine mechanic and/or auto repair service manager, and/or to improve or update skills with respect to such jobs.</li> </ul>
2 <sup>nd</sup> Preference	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Applicant pursuing education and/or training in any trade, such as HVAC, carpentry or plumbing, and/or to improve and update skills with respect to such jobs.</li> </ul>
3 <sup>rd</sup> Preference	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Applicant pursuing job retraining and/or new or different skills necessitated by loss of the individual's job as a result of merger or downsizing at the individual's former employer.</li> </ul>
4 <sup>th</sup> Preference	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Applicant seeking to enter the job market for the first time or applicant seeking to enter the job market after a sustained period of lack of significant full-time employment due to health reasons, the raising of the applicant's child or children and/or the care of an aged or ill relative.</li> </ul>
5 <sup>th</sup> Preference	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Applicant pursuing any other non-traditional, <i>bona fide</i> and reasonable education leading to a recognized degree or certificate of completion.</li> </ul>
6 <sup>th</sup> Preference	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Applicant pursuing traditional college or university education.</li> </ul>
