CARLSON FAMILY EDUCATIONAL FUND

Neal M. Carlson and Joy M. Carlson established this scholarship fund to provide financial assistance to needy and deserving students who are in their junior or senior year of college, seeking degrees in elementary education or special education. Applicants must either be a Kosciusko County resident attending any university or college in Indiana OR a student of Grace College. The Carlsons established this fund in honor of their family members making careers in education of children and youth.

For all Kosciusko County Community Foundation Scholarships ONLY –

- Submit an application for each scholarship applied for with all the required attachments. Staple all attachments to each application, no paper clips. Do not attach information sheets to applications. Submit all applications at the same time, do not mail individually, bundle all applications in the order listed in the index.

In **ONE ENVELOPE SUBMIT THE FOLLOWING TWO** ITEMS, regardless of the number of submitted applications. Do not attach the envelope to any one application. Please write the student's name on the envelope. Failure to submit both items in an envelope with the student's name will result in an incomplete application:

- **ONE PHOTO** – A newsprint quality photo (no larger than 3x5), with the student's name on the back of the photo.
- **ONE FAFSA'S STUDENT AID REPORT (SAR)**, (the report FAFSA returns to you), including your name and the EFC (Expected Family Contribution) number. If ineligible to apply for FAFSA, obtain a Financial Aid Questionnaire from the Community Foundation.

Note: The IRS Form 1040 will not be accepted in place of the SAR.

Required Attachments to the Standard Application Form

Submit a copy of college transcript.

Submit two current letters of recommendation, indicating participation in community service work.

Submit a copy of birth certificate.

Qualifications

- Must be a citizen of the United States of America.
- Must be a resident of Kosciusko County, Indiana OR a student at Grace College.
- Must have graduated from a High School serving Kosciusko County residents OR be a student currently enrolled in Grace College.
- Applicant must be seeking a degree in elementary education and/or special education, and who are in their junior or senior year in college.
- Applicant must have participated in service for community work demonstrated by active involvement in church, civic, nonprofit service, or student organization groups.

Eligibility

- College Student – Junior or Senior Year

All applications and attachments **must** be delivered on or before **April 1**. Awards will be paid to the educational institution after acceptance and must be used for tuition, books, or fees.
