# DAN KINSEY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

A native of Warsaw, Indiana, Dan Kinsey touched countless lives during his thirty-seven year teaching career. He taught English and was involved in many extra-curricular activities which included yearbook sponsor, swim team coach, and directing the school's theater productions at McCutcheon High School in Lafayette, Indiana. His students and colleagues described him as dedicated, creative, energetic, unforgettable and fun. He was a two-time recipient of the Lilly Endowment Teacher Creativity Fellowship, traveling once to study William Shakespeare at the University of Oxford in England, and following Mark Twain's footsteps across the United States. Family and friends chose to honor Dan's memory through this scholarship fund to benefit graduating senior students at McCutcheon High School.

For all Kosciusko County Community Foundation Scholarships ONLY –

- Submit an application for each scholarship applied for with all the required attachments. Staple all attachments to each application, no paper clips. Do not attach information sheets to applications. Submit all applications at the same time, do not mail individually, bundle all applications in the order listed in the index.

In **ONE ENVELOPE SUBMIT** THE FOLLOWING **TWO** ITEMS, regardless of the number of submitted applications. Do not attach the envelope to any one application. Please write the student's name on the envelope. Failure to submit both items in an envelope with the student's name will result in an incomplete application:

- **ONE PHOTO** – A newsprint quality photo (no larger than 3x5), with the student's name on the back of the photo.
- **ONE FAFSA'S STUDENT AID REPORT (SAR)**, which is the report FAFSA returns to you, including your name and the EFC (Expected Family Contribution) number. If ineligible to apply for FAFSA, obtain a Financial Aid Questionnaire from the Community Foundation.

**Note: The IRS Form 1040 will not be accepted in place of the SAR.**

Deadline for Submitting **April 1**

**Required Attachments to the Standard Application Form** Submit a copy of high school transcript including SAT/ACT scores.

Submit two current letters of recommendation; one from current or past teacher and one from a person of your choice who is not related to you.

- Qualifications
- Graduating senior students of **McCutcheon High School, Lafayette, Indiana**
  - Special consideration will be given to students wish to pursue an education major.
  - Must have maintained a cumulative "B" average or its equivalent in their high school studies.
  - Show evidence of financial need.

**Eligibility** **McCutcheon High School** Seniors only – not renewable

May be used for accredited college, university, or vocational school. **Not renewable.**

All applications and attachments **must** be delivered on or before **April 1**. Awards will be paid to the educational institution after acceptance and **must** be used for tuition, books, or fees.
