## DONNY R. CRAW MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Mrs. Lykins knew how important students were to Donny and after his death in a traffic accident, she created this fund in his memory.

For all Kosciusko County Community Foundation Scholarships ONLY –

- Submit an application for each scholarship applied for with all the required attachments. Staple all attachments to each application, no paper clips. Do not attach information sheets to applications. Submit all applications at the same time, do not mail individually, bundle all applications in the order listed in the index.

In **ONE ENVELOPE SUBMIT** THE FOLLOWING **TWO** ITEMS, regardless of the number of submitted applications. Do not attach the envelope to any one application. Please write the student's name on the envelope. Failure to submit both items in an envelope with the student's name will result in an incomplete application:

- **ONE PHOTO** – A newsprint quality photo (no larger than 3x5), with the student's name on the back of the photo.
- **ONE FAFSA'S STUDENT AID REPORT (SAR)**, (the report FAFSA returns to you), including your name and the EFC (Expected Family Contribution) number. If ineligible to apply for FAFSA, obtain a Financial Aid Questionnaire from the Community Foundation.

**Note: The IRS Form 1040 will not be accepted in place of the SAR.**

**Required Attachments to the Standard Application Form** Submit a copy of high school transcript including SAT/ACT scores.

Submit two current letters of recommendation; one from current or past Spanish Language teacher and one from a person of your choice.

Qualifications preference	1 <sup>st</sup>	Graduates of Tippecanoe Valley High School.
	2 <sup>nd</sup> preference	Graduates from any other high school located in Kosciusko County, Indiana. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Special consideration will be given to students who have studied the Spanish language as part of their high school education.</li> <li>▪ Must have maintained a cumulative "B" average or its equivalent in their high school studies.</li> <li>▪ Show evidence of financial need.</li> </ul>

**Eligibility**

- High School Senior – not renewable

May be used for college, university, business school, vocational school, professional training or any accredited post-high school. **Not renewable.**

All applications and attachments **must** be delivered on or before **April 1**. Awards will be paid to the educational institution after acceptance and must be used for tuition, books, or fees.
