



ELMER E. OSTROM SCHOLARSHIP ENDOWMENT

The Elmer E. Ostrom Scholarship Fund was established by Mr. Ostrom in memory of his grandfather, Eric Ostrom, an organist in the Lutheran Church in Liden, Sweden. Mr. Ostrom's hope was to encourage and assist students to follow in his family's tradition of service to their community and church.

For all Kosciusko County Community Foundation Scholarships ONLY –

- Submit an application for each scholarship applied for with all the required attachments. Staple all attachments to each application, no paper clips. Do not attach information sheets to applications. Submit all applications at the same time, do not mail individually, bundle all applications in the order listed in the index.

In **ONE ENVELOPE SUBMIT** THE FOLLOWING **TWO** ITEMS, regardless of the number of submitted applications. Do not attach the envelope to any one application. Please write the student's name on the envelope. Failure to submit both items in an envelope with the student's name will result in an incomplete application:

- **ONE PHOTO** – A newsprint quality photo (no larger than 3x5), with the student's name on the back of the photo.
- **ONE FAFSA'S STUDENT AID REPORT (SAR)**, (the report FAFSA returns to you), including your name and the EFC (Expected Family Contribution) number. If ineligible to apply for FAFSA, obtain a Financial Aid Questionnaire from the Community Foundation.

Note: The IRS Form 1040 will not be accepted in place of the SAR.

Required Attachments to the Standard Application Form Submit a copy of high school transcript including SAT/ACT scores or a copy of college transcript.

Two current letters of recommendation.

Qualifications	▪ Applicant must be a resident of Kosciusko County, Indiana.
1 st Preference	Studying to be an organist in a Lutheran Church
2 nd Preference	Studying to be a church organist for any other church
3 rd Preference	Studying to be an organist
4 th Preference	Pursuing a course of study in music

Comments The student may study at a recognized educational institution, or study with, or be tutored by, a music or organ teacher.

Eligibility	▪ High School Senior ▪ College Student ▪ Past Recipient (Submit letter with application indicating that you are a past recipient)
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All applications and attachments **must** be delivered on or before **April 1**. Scholarship awards may be paid to organizations or instructors.
