Do not attach information sheets to applications. Submit all applications at the same time, do not mail individually, bundle all applications in the order listed in the index.

In **ONE ENVELOPE SUBMIT** the following **one** item regardless of the number of submitted applications. Do not attach the envelope to any one application. Please write the student's name on the envelope. Failure to submit the photo in an envelope with the student's name will result in an incomplete application:

- **ONE PHOTO** – A newsprint quality photo (no larger than 3x5), with the student's name on the back of the photo.

NOTE: The Farrar scholarship does not require submission of the FAFSA's SAR.

Required Attachments to the Standard Application Form Submit a copy of high school transcript including SAT/ACT scores. Submit two current letters of recommendation; and a 100 word essay regarding a personal or family challenge you have overcome.

Qualifications	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Must have graduated from a high school serving Kosciusko County and have attended Madison Elementary School for at least 3 years. ▪ Must have overcome personal or family challenges ▪ Must have been accepted into and attend accredited two or four-year public or private institutions of higher learning. ▪ Preference given to students pursuing degrees in education.
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Eligibility	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ High School Senior – not renewable
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All applications and attachments **must** be delivered on or before **April 1**. Awards will be paid to the educational institution after acceptance and must be used for tuition, books, or fees.
