For all Kosciusko County Community Foundation Scholarships ONLY –

- Submit an application for each scholarship applied for with all the required attachments. Staple all attachments to each application, no paper clips. Do not attach information sheets to applications. Submit all applications at the same time, do not mail individually, bundle all applications in the order listed in the index.

In **ONE ENVELOPE SUBMIT** THE FOLLOWING **TWO** ITEMS, regardless of the number of submitted applications. Do not attach the envelope to any one application. Please write the student's name on the envelope. Failure to submit both items in an envelope with the student's name will result in an incomplete application:

- **ONE PHOTO** – A newsprint quality photo (no larger than 3x5), with the student's name on the back of the photo.
- **ONE FAFSA'S STUDENT AID REPORT (SAR)**, (the report FAFSA returns to you), including your name and the EFC (Expected Family Contribution) number. If ineligible to apply for FAFSA, obtain a Financial Aid Questionnaire from the Community Foundation.

Note: The IRS Form 1040 will not be accepted in place of the SAR.

Required Attachments to the Standard Application Form

- Submit a copy of high school transcript including SAT/ACT scores or a college transcript.
- Submit current letter of recommendation from current or former employer and letter of recommendation indicating service for community work demonstrated by active involvement in church, civic, nonprofit service, or student or youth group organizations.
- Submit copy of birth certificate or documentation of US Citizenship.
- Submit a one hundred (100) words or less essay addressing overcoming challenges and how pursuing freedom through education will impact their future.

Qualifications

- Show evidence of financial need.
- Must be a resident of Kosciusko County, Indiana and must have graduated from a High School serving Kosciusko County residents.
- Applicant must be pursuing post secondary degree in Spanish education, translation, medical studies or other human services.
- Applicant must have completed at least three years of Spanish class at the high school level, or tested out of the equivalent credits at either high school or college level.

Eligibility

- High School Senior
- College Student
- Past Recipient

All applications and attachments **must** be delivered on or before **April 1**. Awards will be paid to the educational institution after acceptance and must be used for tuition, books, or fees.
