



# FRED AND NEDRA BEEBE SCHOLARSHIP ENDOWMENT

The Fred and Nedra Beebe Scholarship Endowment was established by Nedra F. Beebe. For all Kosciusko County Community Foundation Scholarships ONLY –

- Submit an application for each scholarship applied for with all the required attachments. Staple all attachments to each application, no paper clips. Do not attach information sheets to applications. Submit all applications at the same time, do not mail individually, bundle all applications in the order listed in the index.

In **ONE ENVELOPE SUBMIT** THE FOLLOWING **TWO** ITEMS, regardless of the number of submitted applications. Do not attach the envelope to any one application. Please write the student's name on the envelope. Failure to submit both items in an envelope with the student's name will result in an incomplete application:

- **ONE PHOTO** – A newsprint quality photo (no larger than 3x5), with the student's name on the back of the photo.
- **ONE FAFSA'S STUDENT AID REPORT (SAR)**, (the report FAFSA returns to you), including your name and the EFC (Expected Family Contribution) number. If ineligible to apply for FAFSA, obtain a Financial Aid Questionnaire from the Community Foundation.

**Note: The IRS Form 1040 will not be accepted in place of the SAR.**

**Required Attachments to the Standard Application Form** Submit a copy of high school transcript including SAT/ACT scores or a copy of college transcript.

Two current letters of recommendation, one being from a pastor, indicating applicant's active church membership.

2 <sup>nd</sup> Preference	Resident of Monroe Township, Kosciusko County, Indiana
3 <sup>rd</sup> Preference	Resident of Kosciusko County, Indiana
4 <sup>th</sup> Preference	Resident of counties surrounding Kosciusko County, Indiana
Further: 1 <sup>st</sup> Preference	Must be a high school graduate
2 <sup>nd</sup> Preference	Financial Need
3 <sup>rd</sup> Preference	Desire for education beyond the high school level
4 <sup>th</sup> Preference	Mental attitude, citizenship, and character of the applicant
5 <sup>th</sup> Preference	Eligibility of applicant, and/or receipt by applicant of other scholarships or loans
Further: 1 <sup>st</sup> Preference	Maintained active church membership
2 <sup>nd</sup> Preference	Pursue a career in nursing and/or physical therapy
3 <sup>rd</sup> Preference	Achieved a grade point average commensurate with his or her ability or potential
