



THE GASAWAY EDUCATION FUND SCHOLARSHIP

This educational scholarship fund was created by Anabelle Gasaway in tribute to her husband Dr. W. A. Gasaway, a practicing dentist in Warsaw. Prior to marrying Dr. Gasaway, Anabelle Gasaway was a physical education teacher in the Warsaw school district. After her marriage to Dr. Gasaway, Mrs. Gasaway taught aquatic classes, was also active in Girl Scout work and as a hospital volunteer. The Gasaway educational scholarship fund fulfilled their wish to create a scholarship fund for deserving Kosciusko County students who are in need of financial assistance.

For all Kosciusko County Community Foundation Scholarships ONLY –

- Submit an application for each scholarship applied for with all the required attachments. Staple all attachments to each application, no paper clips. Do not attach information sheets to applications. Submit all applications at the same time, do not mail individually, bundle all applications in the order listed in the index.

In **ONE ENVELOPE SUBMIT** THE FOLLOWING **TWO** ITEMS, regardless of the number of submitted applications. Do not attach the envelope to any one application. Please write the student's name on the envelope. Failure to submit both items in an envelope with the student's name will result in an incomplete application:

- **ONE PHOTO** – A newsprint quality photo (no larger than 3x5), with the student's name on the back of the photo.
- **ONE FAFSA'S STUDENT AID REPORT (SAR)**, (the report FAFSA returns to you), including your name and the EFC (Expected Family Contribution) number. If ineligible to apply for FAFSA, obtain a Financial Aid Questionnaire from the Community Foundation.

Note: The IRS Form 1040 will not be accepted in place of the SAR.

Required Attachments to the Standard Application Form Submit a copy of high school transcript including SAT/ACT scores or a copy of college transcript.

Two current letters of recommendation.

Qualifications

- Applicant must be a resident of Kosciusko County, Indiana, or
- have graduated from a high school located in Kosciusko County, Indiana, or
- have graduated from a high school serving Kosciusko County
- Preference is given to applicants maintaining a "B" average or its equivalent.
- Scholarship shall be used to obtain higher education in worthwhile fields of endeavor that may, but need not be, a college or university.
- Show evidence of financial need and a scholarship record indicative of a successful completion of a post-secondary educational program.

Eligibility

- High School Senior
- College Student
- Past Recipient

All applications and attachments **must** be delivered on or before **April 1**. Awards will be paid to the educational institution after acceptance and must be used for tuition, books, or fees.
