ROY HINE PERFORMING ARTS FOUNDATION FUND

Created by the Roy Hine Performing Arts Foundation, Inc. in memory of Roy Hine, who served as the artistic director at the Wagon Wheel theatre in Warsaw, Indiana from 1995 until his death on November 21, 2007. The Fund provides scholarships for students from Indiana, with preference given to residents of Kosciusko and Wabash Counties, who are pursuing a course of study in the performing arts.

For all Kosciusko County Community Foundation Scholarships ONLY –

- Submit an application for each scholarship applied for with all the required attachments. Staple all attachments to each application, no paper clips. Do not attach information sheets to applications. Submit all applications at the same time, do not mail individually, bundle all applications in the order listed in the index.

In **ONE ENVELOPE SUBMIT** the following one item regardless of the number of submitted applications. Do not attach the envelope to any one application. Please write the student's name on the envelope. Failure to submit the photo in an envelope with the student's name will result in an incomplete application:

- **ONE PHOTO** – A newsprint quality photo (no larger than 3x5), with the student's name on the back of the photo.

NOTE: The Hine scholarship does not require submission of the FAFSA's SAR.

Required Attachments to the Standard Application Form

Submit a copy of high school transcript including SAT/ACT scores or a college transcript.
Submit two current letters of recommendation, including one from a drama teacher, coach or other professional who can attest to the student's involvement in the performing arts.

Qualifications

- Must be a resident of Indiana with preference given to residents of Kosciusko and Wabash Counties.
- Must be pursuing post secondary study from an accredited college or university in the field of performing arts, including but not limited to: vocal, musical, radio or television broadcasting, theatre, acting, directing, screen writing, film editing, costume, lighting, and cinematography courses of study.

Eligibility

- High School Senior
- College Student
- Past Recipient

All applications and attachments **must** be delivered on or before **April 1**. Awards will be paid to the educational institution after acceptance and must be used for tuition, books, or fees.
