# INDIANA VAC-FORM, INC. SCHOLARSHIP

This Educational Scholarship Fund was created by Donald and Donna Robinson to assist graduating students of Warsaw Community High School obtain further education in the field of their choice. For all Kosciusko County Community Foundation Scholarships ONLY –

- Submit an application for each scholarship applied for with all the required attachments. Staple all attachments to each application, no paper clips. Do not attach information sheets to applications. Submit all applications at the same time, do not mail individually, bundle all applications in the order listed in the index.

In **ONE ENVELOPE SUBMIT** the following **one** item regardless of the number of submitted applications. Do not attach the envelope to any one application. Please write the student's name on the envelope. Failure to submit the photo in an envelope with the student's name will result in an incomplete application:

- **ONE PHOTO** – A newsprint quality photo (no larger than 3x5), with the student's name on the back of the photo.

**NOTE:** The Indiana Vac scholarship does not require submission of the FAFSA's SAR.

**Required Attachments to the Standard Application Form**

Submit a copy of high school transcript including SAT/ACT scores or a copy of college transcript.

Submit two current letters of recommendation; one from a band or color guard director, and the second from a current or former employer, if possible. If the applicant has little prior employment experience, he/she may substitute a letter of recommendation from a person familiar with the applicant's participation in a substantial non-school related activity.

Submit a letter or written statement setting forth the applicant's educational and/or vocational, goals.

Qualifications

- Must be a member of the Warsaw Community High School Band or Color Guard during their senior year.
- Must be a senior at Warsaw Community High School and planning to attend a vocational, two, or four-year school, college or university.
- The scholarship must be used to obtain post secondary school education in either a vocational, two or four-year school, college or university.
- While grade point average will be considered, the applicant must foremost demonstrate a positive work ethic and willingness to work towards a goal.
- Students participating in a program of home study in lieu of attending Warsaw Community High School are eligible for this scholarship if they participate in the band or color guard during their final year of high school home study program.

Eligibility

- High School Senior
- **Past Recipient only** may reapply

All applications and attachments must be delivered on or before **April 1**. Awards will be paid to the educational institution after acceptance and must be used for tuition, books, or fees.
