The SAR must include <u>your name</u> and <u>Estimated Family Contribution (EFC) number</u>.</li> <li>3. In order to be given preference – proof of employment for more than one year including a letter of reference from employer stating dates of work history and continual employment in the health care industry in Kosciusko County.</li> <li>4.
