MAX TRUEX MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Max Truex was a graduate of Warsaw High School who set state and national records in the mile run as a senior. Max went on to compete at the 1960 Olympics in the 10,000 meter run. He was awarded Warsaw's Man of the Year in 1960 at the age of 24. He remains the youngest individual to ever win the award. After graduating from college, he practiced law in southern California and later moved to Boston. Friends and family contributed funds to establish the Max Truex Scholarship Fund as a memorial to Max.

- **ONE PHOTO** – A newsprint quality photo (no larger than 3x5), with the student's name on the back of the photo.

NOTE: The Truex scholarship does not require submission of the FAFSA's SAR.

Deadline for Submitting **April 1**

Required Attachments to the Standard Application Form Submit a copy of high school transcript including SAT/ACT scores or a copy of college transcript.

Two current letters of recommendation, one from a teacher and one personal reference.

- Qualifications
- Must be a resident of Kosciusko County, Indiana and a graduating senior of Warsaw Community High School.
 - Scholarship will be used to obtain higher education at an eligible institution which would include universities, accredited colleges, vocational centers and business schools.
 - Must have at least a "B" grade average through high school career.
 - Participation in high school sports with preference given to those participating in track.

Eligibility

- High School Senior

All applications and attachments **must** be delivered on or before **April 1**. Awards will be paid to the educational institution after acceptance and must be used for tuition, books, or fees.
