For all Kosciusko County Community Foundation Scholarships ONLY –

- Submit an application for each scholarship applied for with all the required attachments. Staple all attachments to each application, no paper clips. Do not attach information sheets to applications. Submit all applications at the same time, do not mail individually, bundle all applications in the order listed in the index.

In **ONE ENVELOPE SUBMIT** THE FOLLOWING **TWO** ITEMS, regardless of the number of submitted applications. Do not attach the envelope to any one application. Please write the student's name on the envelope. Failure to submit both items in an envelope with the student's name will result in an incomplete application:

- **ONE PHOTO** – A newsprint quality photo (no larger than 3x5), with the student's name on the back of the photo.
- **ONE FAFSA'S STUDENT AID REPORT (SAR)**, (the report FAFSA returns to you), including your name and the EFC (Expected Family Contribution) number. If ineligible to apply for FAFSA, obtain a Financial Aid Questionnaire from the Community Foundation.

Note: The IRS Form 1040 will not be accepted in place of the SAR.

Required Attachments to the Standard Application Form	Two <u>current</u> letters of recommendation of which one must be from a current or previous employer and one from a pastor, youth minister or community service leader. Applicant shall submit a transcript of high school credits, containing GPA and SAT/ACT scores.
Qualifications	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Must have attended Harrison Elementary School and have graduated from Warsaw Community High School. ▪ Must have graduated in upper 50% of class. ▪ Show evidence of financial need. ▪ Demonstrate good work ethic. ▪ Applicant shall submit a written essay on applicant's goals including career choice if identified. ▪ Applicant must participate in community service through church, service organization, or youth group.
Eligibility	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ High School Senior – not renewable

May be used for college, university, business school, vocational school, professional training or any accredited post-high school.

All applications and materials must be delivered on or before **April 1**. Awards will be paid to the educational institution after acceptance and must be used for tuition, books, or fees.
