This educational fund was established to grant scholarships to worthy high school graduates who are in need of financial assistance to enable them to obtain higher education or training. The scholar must be pursuing a degree in higher education as a teacher or in the study of law through Harvard University, Indiana University and/or Purdue University.

For all Kosciusko County Community Foundation Scholarships ONLY –

- Submit an application for each scholarship applied for with all the required attachments. Staple all attachments to each application, no paper clips. Do not attach information sheets to applications. Submit all applications at the same time, do not mail individually, bundle all applications in the order listed in the index.

In **ONE ENVELOPE SUBMIT** THE FOLLOWING **TWO** ITEMS, regardless of the number of submitted applications. Do not attach the envelope to any one application. Please write the student's name on the envelope. Failure to submit both items in an envelope with the student's name will result in an incomplete application:

- **ONE PHOTO** – A newsprint quality photo (no larger than 3x5), with the student's name on the back of the photo.
- **ONE FAFSA'S STUDENT AID REPORT (SAR)**, (the report FAFSA returns to you), including your name and the EFC (Expected Family Contribution) number. If ineligible to apply for FAFSA, obtain a Financial Aid Questionnaire from the Community Foundation.

Note: The IRS Form 1040 will not be accepted in place of the SAR.

Deadline For Submitting **April 1**

Required Attachments to the Standard Application Form

Submit a copy of high school transcript including SAT/ACT scores or a copy of college transcript.

Must provide two current letters of recommendation from a teacher, employer or other professional recommendation.

Qualifications

- Must be pursuing a degree in higher education as a teacher or in the study of law through Harvard University, Indiana University and/or Purdue University (and their satellite campuses).
- Must be a resident of Kosciusko County, Indiana and have graduated from a high school providing education for Kosciusko County, Indiana residents.
- Must be or have been a resident for 5 or more years attending any combination of a grade school, middle school and/or high school providing education for Kosciusko County, Indiana.

Eligibility

- High School Senior
- College Student
- Past Recipient

All applications and attachments must be delivered on or before **April 1**. Awards will be paid to the educational institution after acceptance and must be used for tuition, books, or fees.
