



PURDUE SCHOLARS OF KOSCIUSKO COUNTY SCHOLARSHIP FUND

This educational scholarship fund was created by the Purdue Club of Kosciusko County. The scholarship shall provide financial assistance to needy and deserving students who are in their third or fourth year of attendance at Purdue University.

For all Kosciusko County Community Foundation Scholarships ONLY –

- Submit an application for each scholarship applied for with all the required attachments. Staple all attachments to each application, no paper clips. Do not attach information sheets to applications. Submit all applications at the same time, do not mail individually, bundle all applications in the order listed in the index.

In **ONE ENVELOPE SUBMIT** THE FOLLOWING **TWO** ITEMS, regardless of the number of submitted applications. Do not attach the envelope to any one application. Please write the student's name on the envelope. Failure to submit both items in an envelope with the student's name will result in an incomplete application:

- **ONE PHOTO** – A newsprint quality photo (no larger than 3x5), with the student's name on the back of the photo.
- **ONE FAFSA'S STUDENT AID REPORT (SAR)**, (the report FAFSA returns to you), including your name and the EFC (Expected Family Contribution) number. If ineligible to apply for FAFSA, obtain a Financial Aid Questionnaire from the Community Foundation.

Note: The IRS Form 1040 will not be accepted in place of the SAR.

Required Attachments to the Standard Application Form

- Submit a copy of college transcript.
- Two current letters of recommendation.
- Copy of birth certificate or documentation of US Citizenship.

- Qualifications
- Applicant must be a citizen of the United States of America.
 - Applicant must be a resident of Kosciusko County, Indiana.
 - Applicant must have graduated from a High School serving Kosciusko County residents.
 - Applicant must have participated in service for community work demonstrated by active involvement in church, civic, nonprofit service, or student organization groups.
 - Applicant must have demonstrated work ethic.
 - Show evidence of financial need.

Eligibility

- College Student – third or fourth year student enrolled at Purdue University

All materials **must** be delivered on or before **April 1**. Awards will be paid to the educational institution after acceptance and must be used for tuition, books, or fees.
