



## RALPH AND LUCETTA FRANTZ SCHOLARSHIP

Ralph and Lucetta Frantz, a sister and brother, who lived on a farm south of Warsaw, created this Educational Scholarship Fund. Both Lucetta and Ralph were very community minded with participation in many community activities. Lucetta taught Sunday School at the Walnut Creek United Methodist Church for 68 years. They were both active in the American Red Cross, Kosciusko County Farm Bureau, Kosciusko Historical Association, and the Lakeland Community Concert Association.

Do not attach information sheets to applications. Submit all applications at the same time, do not mail individually, bundle all applications in the order listed in the index.

In **ONE ENVELOPE SUBMIT** THE FOLLOWING **TWO** ITEMS, regardless of the number of submitted applications. Do not attach the envelope to any one application. Please write the student's name on the envelope. Failure to submit both items in an envelope with the student's name will result in an incomplete application:

- **ONE PHOTO** – A newsprint quality photo (no larger than 3x5), with the student's name on the back of the photo.
- **ONE FAFSA'S STUDENT AID REPORT (SAR)**, (the report FAFSA returns to you), including your name and the EFC (Expected Family Contribution) number. If ineligible to apply for FAFSA, obtain a Financial Aid Questionnaire from the Community Foundation.

**Note: The IRS Form 1040 will not be accepted in place of the SAR.**

### Required Attachments to the Standard Application Form

Two current letters of reference; one must be from a teacher or school administrator.  
Submit a copy of high school transcript including SAT/ACT scores or a copy of college transcript.

### Qualifications

- Show evidence of financial need and a scholastic record indicative of a successful college career.
- Applicant must be a resident of and have graduated from a high school serving Kosciusko County, Indiana.

### Eligibility

Eligible institutions are not limited to but would include; universities, accredited colleges, business schools, professional training institutions, vocational training centers and night courses in the public school system.

- High School Senior
- College Student
- Past Recipient

All applications and attachments **must** be delivered on or before **April 1**. Awards will be paid to the educational institution after acceptance and must be used for tuition, books, or fees.
