The fund shall provide for academic study beyond high school including but not limited to undergraduate, graduate and professional levels.

For all Kosciusko County Community Foundation Scholarships ONLY –

- Submit an application for each scholarship applied for with all the required attachments. Staple all attachments to each application, no paper clips. Do not attach information sheets to applications. Submit all applications at the same time, do not mail individually, bundle all applications in the order listed in the index.

In **ONE ENVELOPE SUBMIT** the following **one** item regardless of the number of submitted applications. Do not attach the envelope to any one application. Please write the student's name on the envelope. Failure to submit the photo in an envelope with the student's name will result in an incomplete application:

- **ONE PHOTO** – A newsprint quality photo (no larger than 3x5), with the student's name on the back of the photo.

NOTE: The Reafsnnyder scholarship does not require submission of the FAFSA's SAR.

Required Attachments to the Standard Application Form Submit a copy of high school transcript, which may OR MAY NOT include SAT or ACT scores or a college transcript.

Three current letters of recommendation: 2 from teachers/instructors/professors and 1 from a practitioner of the profession which the applicant intends to pursue.

- Qualifications
- Must be a graduate of Warsaw Community High School.
 - Must maintain a B average.
 - Must be studying pharmacy, nursing or medicine.
 - Must show promise and interest in their chosen field of study.

- Eligibility
- Warsaw Community High School senior or past graduate
 - Current college student: undergraduate, graduate or professional studies.

All applications and attachments **must** be delivered on or before **April 1**. Awards will be paid to the educational institution after acceptance and must be used for tuition, books, or fees.
