



THE ROB MORTON SCHOLARSHIP FUND

A gift from the estate of Marjorie D. Morton established this scholarship in memory of her son, Rob Morton, a Warsaw High School junior who tragically died at a young age. The scholarship will provide scholarship assistance to needy and deserving students who are residents of Kosciusko County and who have graduated from a high school that serves Kosciusko County residents.

For all Kosciusko County Community Foundation Scholarships ONLY –

- Submit an application for each scholarship applied for with all the required attachments. Staple all attachments to each application, no paper clips. Do not attach information sheets to applications. Submit all applications at the same time, do not mail individually, bundle all applications in the order listed in the index.

In **ONE ENVELOPE SUBMIT** THE FOLLOWING **TWO** ITEMS, regardless of the number of submitted applications. Do not attach the envelope to any one application. Please write the student's name on the envelope. Failure to submit both items in an envelope with the student's name will result in an incomplete application:

- **ONE PHOTO** – A newsprint quality photo (no larger than 3x5), with the student's name on the back of the photo.
- **ONE FAFSA'S STUDENT AID REPORT (SAR)**, (the report FAFSA returns to you), including your name and the EFC (Expected Family Contribution) number. If ineligible to apply for FAFSA, obtain a Financial Aid Questionnaire from the Community Foundation.

Note: The IRS Form 1040 will not be accepted in place of the SAR.

Required Attachments to the Standard Application Form Submit a copy of high school transcript including SAT/ACT scores or a copy of college transcript.

Two current letters of recommendation speaking about the student's participation in community service through church, youth groups or civic organizations.

All applications and attachments **must** be delivered on or before **April 1**. Awards will be paid to the educational institution after acceptance and must be used for tuition, books, or fees.
