Robert Gilliam owned a lumber business in Leesburg, Indiana, was active in civic affairs, as well as the Masonic Lodge and the Leesburg Methodist Church. Emma Gilliam was a homemaker and was an active parishioner of the Leesburg Methodist Church and the Eastern Star Lodge. Their daughter, Florence, taught elementary school in Leesburg and was also active in the Eastern Star.

Please write the student's name on the envelope. Failure to submit both items in an envelope with the student's name will result in an incomplete application:

- **ONE PHOTO** – A newsprint quality photo (no larger than 3x5), with the student's name on the back of the photo.
- **ONE FAFSA'S STUDENT AID REPORT (SAR)**, (the report FAFSA returns to you), including your name and the EFC (Expected Family Contribution) number. If ineligible to apply for FAFSA, obtain a Financial Aid Questionnaire from the Community Foundation.

**Note: The IRS Form 1040 will not be accepted in place of the SAR.**
