Submit an **ONLINE** application by visiting <http://www.kcfoundation.org/seekingfunds/scholarships.php> and clicking on the Non-Traditional Application link. Paper applications will not be accepted for non-traditional scholarships. Please note this online application feature will not be activated until June 1 of each year.

If you do not have access to a computer with Internet, check with your local library or college computer lab for computer availability.
