SETH V. LEWIS SCHOLARSHIP

This Educational Fund was created by Christiane Lewis in memory of her husband to provide scholarships to needy individuals who are seeking training and education necessary to become licensed by the State of Indiana as nurses and in any other medical or medically related field.

For all Kosciusko County Community Foundation Scholarships ONLY –

- Submit an application for each scholarship applied for with all the required attachments. Staple all attachments to each application, no paper clips. Do not attach information sheets to applications. Submit all applications at the same time, do not mail individually, bundle all applications in the order listed in the index.

In **ONE ENVELOPE SUBMIT** THE FOLLOWING **TWO** ITEMS, regardless of the number of submitted applications. Do not attach the envelope to any one application. Please write the student's name on the envelope. Failure to submit both items in an envelope with the student's name will result in an incomplete application:

- **ONE PHOTO** – A newsprint quality photo (no larger than 3x5), with the student's name on the back of the photo.
- **ONE FAFSA'S STUDENT AID REPORT (SAR)**, (the report FAFSA returns to you), including your name and the EFC (Expected Family Contribution) number. If ineligible to apply for FAFSA, obtain a Financial Aid Questionnaire from the Community Foundation.

Note: The IRS Form 1040 will not be accepted in place of the SAR.

Deadline for Submitting **April 1**

Required Attachments to the Standard Application Form

Submit a copy of high school transcript including SAT/ACT scores or a college transcript.

Current letter of recommendation from either their high school principal, a college administrator, or a former or current employer.

Qualifications

- Must be a high school graduate and a Kosciusko County, Indiana resident for the twelve months prior to applying.
- Show evidence of financial need.
- Scholastic and/or work record indicative of successfully completing the state licensing requirements (in order of priority) for a nurses' aide, nurse, or in any other medical or medically related field.

Eligibility

- High School Senior
- College Student
- Past Recipient

All applications and attachments ***must*** be delivered on or before **April 1**. Awards will be paid to the educational institution after acceptance and must be used for tuition, books, or fees.
