TERESA K. JONES MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

This award is given in loving memory of Terri Jones, who lost her life in a tragic event in 1986. Established in 1991, by her parents, Bettye Jones and the late Robert W. Jones, to honor the memory of Terri on the occasion of her 20th anniversary of her graduation from Warsaw Community High School. The award is granted to a Warsaw Community High School graduating young woman seeking to improve her skills or advance her education by attending an accredited or certified college or educational program.

For all Kosciusko County Community Foundation Scholarships ONLY –

- Submit an application for each scholarship applied for with all the required attachments. Staple all attachments to each application, no paper clips. Do not attach information sheets to applications. Submit all applications at the same time, do not mail individually, bundle all applications in the order listed in the index.

In **ONE ENVELOPE SUBMIT** THE FOLLOWING **TWO** ITEMS, regardless of the number of submitted applications. Do not attach the envelope to any one application. Please write the student's name on the envelope. Failure to submit both items in an envelope with the student's name will result in an incomplete application:

- **ONE PHOTO** – A newsprint quality photo (no larger than 3x5), with the student's name on the back of the photo.
- **ONE FAFSA'S STUDENT AID REPORT (SAR)**, (the report FAFSA returns to you), including your name and the EFC (Expected Family Contribution) number. If ineligible to apply for FAFSA, obtain a Financial Aid Questionnaire from the Community Foundation.

Note: The IRS Form 1040 will not be accepted in place of the SAR.

Required Attachments to the Standard Application Form Submit a copy of high school transcript including SAT/ACT scores.

Two current letters of recommendation.

Copy of birth certificate or documentation of US Citizenship.

- Qualifications
- Must be single female.
 - Must be a graduating senior from Warsaw Community High School.
 - Must be a resident of Kosciusko County, Indiana.
 - Must be a citizen of the United States of America.

- Eligibility
- Female High School Senior from Warsaw Community High School

All applications and attachments **must** be delivered on or before **April 1**. Awards will be paid to the educational institution after acceptance and must be used for tuition, books, or fees.
