## WILSON-RHODES MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Steven and Jane were graduates of Wawasee High School and Indiana University in Bloomington. They had been married a short time when they died in a traffic accident. Their friends and families wished to remember Steven and Jane's love for our community and Indiana University through a memorial scholarship endowment fund. This scholarship was established in memory of Steven Rhodes and Jane Wilson-Rhodes. The scholarship is granted to a student graduating from Wawasee High School who will be attending Indiana University at Bloomington.

For all Kosciusko County Community Foundation Scholarships ONLY –

- Submit an application for each scholarship applied for with all the required attachments. Staple all attachments to each application, no paper clips. Do not attach information sheets to applications. Submit all applications at the same time, do not mail individually, bundle all applications in the order listed in the index.

In **ONE ENVELOPE SUBMIT** THE FOLLOWING **TWO** ITEMS, regardless of the number of submitted applications. Do not attach the envelope to any one application. Please write the student's name on the envelope. Failure to submit both items in an envelope with the student's name will result in an incomplete application:

- **ONE PHOTO** – A newsprint quality photo (no larger than 3x5), with the student's name on the back of the photo.
- **ONE FAFSA'S STUDENT AID REPORT (SAR)**, (is the report FAFSA returns to you), including your name and the EFC (Expected Family Contribution) number. If ineligible to apply for FAFSA, obtain a Financial Aid Questionnaire from the Community Foundation.

**Note: The IRS Form 1040 will not be accepted in place of the SAR.**

**Required Attachments to the Standard Application Form** Submit a copy of high school transcript including SAT/ACT scores or a copy of college transcript.

Two current letters of recommendation.

Brief essay (100 words or less) stating reasons for desiring a college education.
